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

Presentation Day

Our Presentation Day is being held on **Monday, 11 December, 2024.** This annual event celebrates and acknowledges the individual effort and progress in learning of every student in every class. Parents are invited to their child's classroom from **9:05-9:25am** for the **presentation of Learning Certificates** to each student. Premier's Reading & Sporting Challenge will also be presented to students who completed these programs throughout the school year. Our formal **Presentation Assembly will be held from 9:30am to approximately 11:00am**, in our school hall, to recognise academic achievement, as well as announcing **2024 School Leaders**. Each class will have awards to present to students at Presentation Assembly on a pro-rata basis. This means teachers will present one award per 5 students in their class. Awards will include a certificate and a book voucher for QBD Bookstore at Macarthur Square. This gives students the flexibility to select an appropriate book at their leisure from a wider range of books than that available at a school book fair.

Attendance and Absences

Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday

• exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unexplained on the student's record.

Student Items Required to Be Purchased For 2024

Students are requested to purchase the following item for 2024. You may like to purchase these over the school holidays.

K-6: Library bag, paint shirt, 2 boxes of tissues, 2 x paper towel rolls, 1 soap bottle cream hand wash (optional)

3-6: Pencil case (no bigger than 30cm x 15cm) to include these items:

2 lead pencils – HB preferably, black felt tip pen (optional), scissors, 2 glue sticks, standard ruler, 1 soft white rubber, coloured pencils, sharpener, 2 x blue and red ball point pens. **(Pens not needed for Year 3 students.)**


Updating School Records
