
#### Download School Bytes Parent App

School Bytes provides a parent portal to help your school communicate with you. Our school uses the parent portal for various things, including online permission notes, attendance, and payments, which can be accessed via a secure link. The School Bytes parent portal enables you to view all your children in one portal and process payments for multiple siblings in one transaction. All fees can be paid off in instalments, by adjusting the amount you wish to pay at the time. Please assist us by downloading the App and using this system to make payments and return notes.

#### **Huskisson Class**

In Mathematics, Huskisson have been developing their worded problem-solving skills and complete a daily word warm up for Mathematics lessons. They have been learning to break the process down into steps to ensure they comprehend what the question is asking them to do and how they can solve the problem. Students recently had a go at writing a worded problem of their own for a peer to solve. In English, Huskisson have just finished publishing their 'Rowan of Rin' writing. Students drew a dragon to go with their published writing. They used acrylic paint markers to colour in the head and will use watercolour paints to colour the background.



#### **Kiandra Class**

Kiandra students have put their estimation and measurement skills to the test as they explored the topics of volume and capacity in Mathematics. Students used everyday containers to identify how much liquid they could hold. We took our learning outside into the sunshine and the students were engaged in hands on learning. After reading the story Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes, we had the wonderful Mrs Kelly visit us to help us make our very own origami paper cranes. This task was challenging, but the students were resilient and persevered. We are looking forward to finishing them this week. Kiandra students are now in the process of writing an instructional text on how to make Chinese lanterns.

#### 100-point residential address check in schools with a designated intake area
